How a Marine deploys over seas.

Specific Purpose:

At the end of my speech the audience should be able to describe the 3 steps a marine reservist takes to deploy.

Introduction:

Imagine that you joined the Marine Reserves right after high school to give back a little something to your country and maybe even help you pay for college. You have done all your training and now you are a deployable marine reservist. Everything is going great you have great job, a hot girlfriend, and are doing great in classes. This all a sudden changes when you get that phone call from your command saying you are deploying overseas you need to report in by such and such date and time.

Today I would like to explain the 3 stages a Marine Reservist goes through to deploy overseas: The first stage being the pre-deployment stage. The second stage the actual deployment. Finally, the last stage the post-deployment stage.

Understanding these 3 stages a marine reservist goes through when deploying for an overseas deployment will help you better understand the process they go through in going from a civilian world, to a war zone and then back to the civilian world.
